PAST

Take in a performance from the world's best-known playwright at **Shakespeare's Globe**. Or if you prefer you can go on a tour of the venue, a reconstruction of the theatre from 1599.

Witness the **Tower of London's** 700 year old tradition, the Ceremony of the Keys at 21:30 every night (tickets must be booked online in advance).

The **Old Royal Naval College** forms part of the UNESCO World Heritage site of Maritime Greenwich, and contains what has been described as "Britain's Sistine Chapel". Tickets are discounted on the first Sunday of the month (April 6th).

Over 200 years old, the **National Gallery** on Trafalgar Square hosts work from Da Vinci, van Gogh, Monet and others.

See world-class performances at the **National Theatre** on Southbank, with nightly shows and additional matinees on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

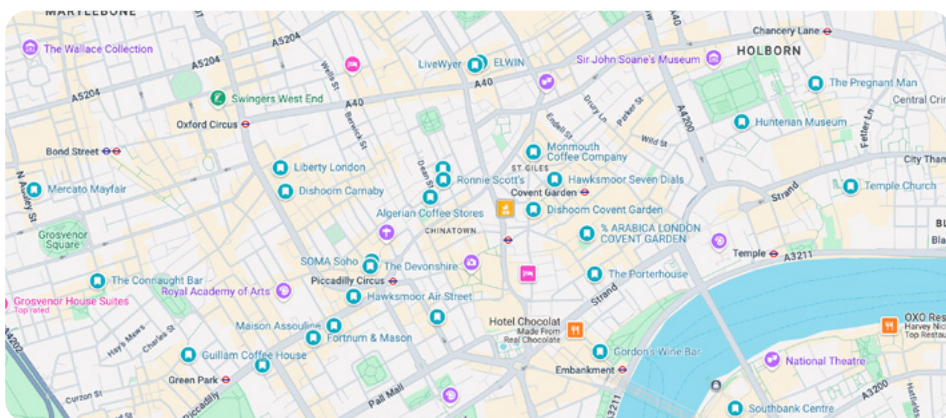

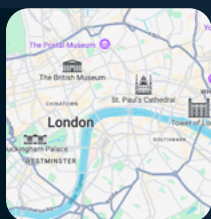
