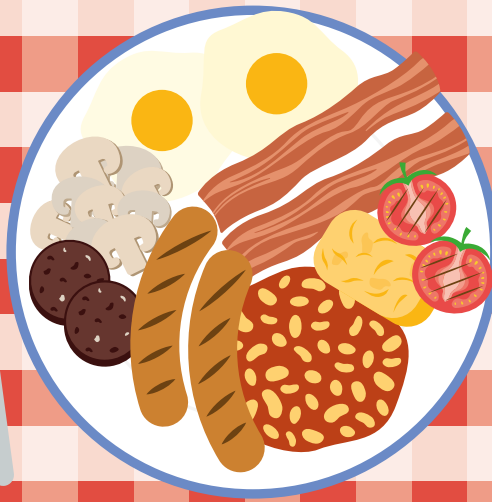
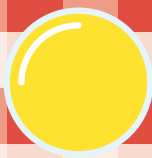

- The iconic Victorian-era **Battersea Power Station** now houses luxury

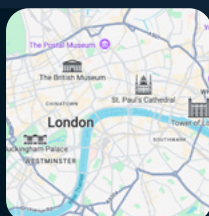
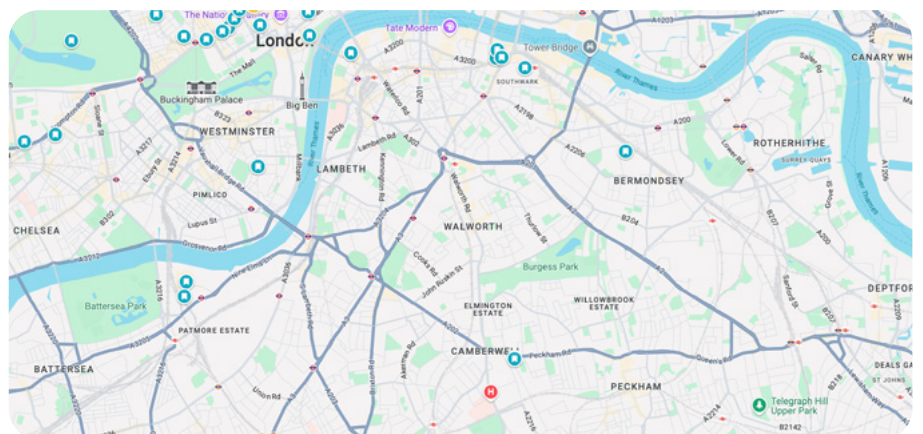
