to play English Pool, American Pool or Snooker, not to mention numerous big screens for watching whatever game is on at the time.

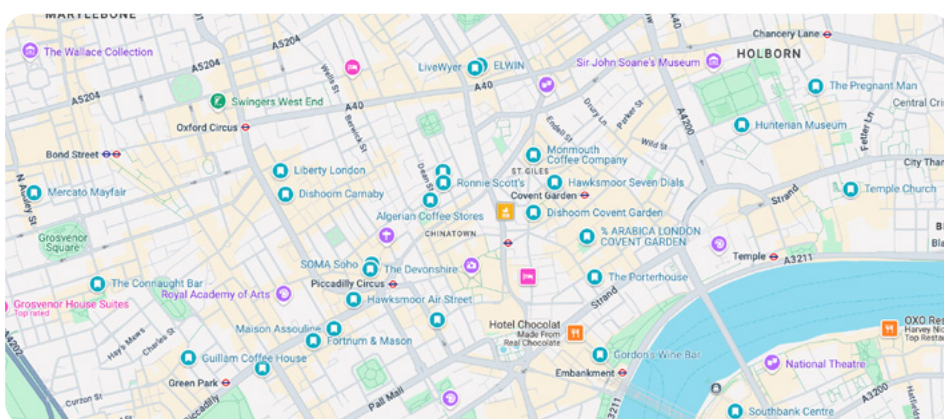

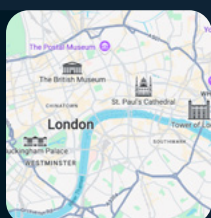
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
